4.1 KL&WN Borough Council: Cllr. James Moriarty, as follows:

There is a full council meeting tomorrow (3/12/20) and the proposed restriction on the number of questions will be limited to 30 minutes. Originally this was unrestricted, then with a limit of 2 per councillor. Great concern as seen as an attack on democracy but will be voted on tomorrow.

Councillor Moriarty was thanked for his regular attendance and work in the parish.

10. Communications/Correspondence – general as sent out via emails.

Kind offer from a parishioner of oak samplings discussed but as no land is owned by the Parish Council a note to be sent to the parishioner thanking for the very kind offer.
A thank you had been received from J Newell for the donation towards the Churchyard maintenance. It was mentioned that the frontage at the Old Rectory looked good, but the stones had to be removed by notice from Norfolk County Council. A border of pansies was also not allowed but daffodils were.

- 11.1 Community Speed Watch –GR - The Sam unit will be made available to Fitcham and it was decided to request that our speed watch figures are sent to planning regarding the proposed development at 22 Lynn Road.
